

Organizational rules during the tournament Prague Grand Prix 2021

1. Registration will take place in front of the entrance to the hall (in case of bad weather condition in the lobby near the entrance of the hall) on Friday 2nd July from 17.00 to 20.00.
 2. All players, coaches, umpires, staff members and other accompanying persons (only in case they want to enter the hall) are obliged to submit a confirmation during registration that:
 - a. the person has passed a negative RT-PCR test for the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus with a negative result no later than 7 days
 - b. the person has passed a negative POC antigen test for SARS-CoV-2 virus with a negative result no later than 72 hours
 - c. the person has undergone a laboratory-confirmed Covid-19 disease, the isolation period expired and have not elapsed more than 180 days from the first positive POC antigen test for SARS-CoV-2 virus or RT-PCR test for SARS-CoV-2 virus
 - d. the person has been vaccinated against covid-19 and prove a national certificate of vaccination issued at least in English by an authorized entity operating in the Czech Republic or another Member State of the European Union, which contains data about the vaccinated person, vaccine type, vaccine date and subject identification and
 - i. passed at least 22 days but not more than 90 days since the first dose of vaccine was applied in the case of a two-dose shots vaccine, if second dose has not been applied
 - ii. passed at least 22 days but not more than 9 months since the first dose of vaccine was applied in the case of a two-dose shots vaccine, if both doses was applied
 - iii. passed at least 14 days but not more than 9 months since the dose of vaccine was applied in the case of a single shot vaccine
 - it is necessary to pass the POC antigen test for SARS-CoV-2 virus not before Friday, 2nd July, to make the test valid throughout the tournament
 - it is necessary to pass the RT-PCR test for SARS-CoV-2 virus not before Monday, 28th June, to make the test valid throughout the tournament.
3. The temperature will be measured every day before entering the hall - preferably staff members, referees and umpires and players.
4. It is possible to enter the hall only with a mask protection and all participants are obliged to wear it in all non-playing areas of the hall (corridors, changing rooms, tribune).
5. The entrance to the playing area is allowed only for players who go to play their match, their coaches, umpires, referee and his deputies, the staff members and paramedics. It is not necessary to wear a mask in the playing area.
6. Disinfection will be available in all areas of the hall.
7. The organizer provides continuous disinfection of the tables.
8. After the match, the players can greet the opponent, his coach and umpire only symbolically.
9. The balls will be changed regularly during the tournament.
